Cold-holding equipment used for Time/Temperature Control for Safety food shall have at least one thermometer in an easily viewed location. Thermometer provided by female person-in-charge during inspection.
37	3-302.12 (C) Observed in kitchen on metal shelf clear plastic containers of dry food substances without name identifying contents on containers. Working containers holding food or food ingredients that are removed from their original packages for use in the food establishment shall be identified with the common name of the food. Dry food substances were bread crumbs and white rice according to female person-in-charge, and labeled by female person-in-charge during inspection.
