





"Food employee" means an individual working with unpackaged food, food equipment or utensils, or food-contact surfaces. Food handler certification is required 30 days from the hire date of food employees.

Ensure compliance with Smoke-Free IL Act - public places and places of employment must be completely smoke-free inside and within 15 feet from entrances, exits, windows that open and ventilation intakes; signage posted at entrances & exits; no vaping or e-cigarette use in food & drink prep area, dishwashing area, and storage area; no smoking within building structure.
