

NOTICE TO VOTERS

ALL PERSONS MAY REGISTER TO VOTE who are citizens of the United States and will be 18 years of age on or before November 6, 2018, GENERAL ELECTION DAY, and will have lived in the State of Illinois and in the precinct of residence 30 days prior to the date of the GENERAL ELECTION.

If you are registered but your latest Voter Identification Card does not reflect your current address you must report the changes in writing. If your name has changed, you must re-register. Registration and name changes requires two forms of ID, one with current name and address.

TUESDAY, October 9, 2018, IS THE LAST DAY FOR VOTER REGISTRATION OR TRANSFER with the ELECTION AUTHORITY and Deputy Registrars before the GENERAL ELECTION. **ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION** continues through the Illinois State Board of Elections website at www.elections.il.gov from Wednesday, October 10, 2018 through Sunday, October 21, 2018.

GRACE PERIOD registration or change of address will begin on October 10, 2018, and ends on November 6, 2018, only within the County Clerk's Office. Use of the privilege requires the applicant to present two forms of ID, one with current name/address, and to vote on the day of application.

VOTE BY MAIL applications will be available August 8, 2018, through November 1, 2018. Ballots will not be mailed any earlier than September 27, 2018, and continue through November 1, 2018. Ballots must be postmarked or returned by November 6, 2018.

Applications for Ballot are available for printable download or online submission at www.woodford-county.org – click on the “Vote” picture when it scrolls on the home page. Under Applications – Choose Vote By Mail-Online Application or Vote By Mail-Printable Application. An application can also be requested by calling the Woodford County Clerk's Office. Ballots will be mailed beginning September 27, 2018.

EARLY VOTING will be conducted at the Woodford County Courthouse, 115 N. Main, Room 104, Eureka, Illinois.

- October 15 - 19, 2018 (Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
- October 22 - 26, 2018 (Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
- October 29 - 31, 2018 (Monday through Wednesday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
- November 1, 2018 (Thursday from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.)
- November 2, 2018 (Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
- November 3, 2018 (Saturday from 8 a.m. to Noon)
- November 5, 2018 (Monday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)
