Tri-County Continue to Offer COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics

Following CDC, FDA, and IDPH guidelines, local health departments in the Tri-County has paused administration of Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine clinics. Other Moderna or Pfizer clinics will continue.

Out of an abundance of caution, all one-day clinics offering Johnson & Johnson, which requires only one dose, have been paused by the CDC and the FDA, pending a review of 6 cases of a rare blood clot. CDC will convene a meeting of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices to assess potential significance.

People who have received the J&J vaccine who develop severe headache, abdominal pain, leg pain, or shortness of breath within 3 weeks after vaccination should contact their health care provider. Right now, these adverse events appear to be extremely rare.
